### **In-Person Worship**

Worship in the sanctuary will resume on Sunday, June 7.

In order to have smaller crowds, we will hold two separate worship services on June 7, 14 & 21:

#### **First Service**

9:00 – 9:45 a.m.

Sunday School: No

Nursery: Yes

Music: Praise songs only (no hymns)

#### **Second Service**

10:30 – 11:15 a.m.

Sunday School: No

Nursery: Yes

Music: Organ & piano, hymns, choir may sing

### **Details of In-Person Worship**

- Pastor James Byers will preach a sermon for both services.
- We will not celebrate the Lord's Supper these first three weeks.
- Offering plates will not be passed these first three weeks. Two plates will be located at the back of the sanctuary by the doors; and two will be located at the front of the sanctuary on either side of the Communion table.
- No coffee fellowship time is allowed prior to services.

### **Safety Recommendations**

- Everyone is encouraged - but not required - to wear masks.
- We will not regulate social distancing by closing off pews, but everyone is encouraged to be mindful of keeping a 6-foot distance from others.
- The balcony will be open, and we encourage everyone to spread out.
- People who are at high risk or have pre-existing medical conditions should seriously consider whether or not they should be in large gatherings.

### **Online Worship**

People who are not yet comfortable being in large gatherings can continue watching online. Live streaming will begin at 10:45 a.m. each Sunday.
